ANNA HENNING, BORN ANNA WEYERBACHER, ON JULY 16, 1767, SECOND OLDEST DAUGHTER OF JOHANNES AND HIS WIFE CATHERINE, DIED AUGUST 2, 1794. ANNA WAS THE FIRST OF ADAM HENNING'S THREE WIVES. ADAM AND HIS THREE WIVES ARE ALL BURIED IN THIS LITTLE FARM CEMETERY IN CENTRE COUNTY. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT ANNA WAS THE SECOND OF JOHANNES' DAUGHTERS STOLEN BY THE INDIANS. THE ELDEST, ELIZABETH, MARRIED INTO THE TRIBE BUT HER SISTER RETURNED HOME.

WE SEND BELATED BIRTHDAY GREETING TO MRS. HATTIE SOILLIDAY AT THE PHOEBE HOME IN ALLENTOWN, WHO WAS 93 ON VALENTINE'S DAY. WE WELCOME MISS LADORA WIREBAUGH OF TOLEDO, OHIO, WHO WAS 95 LAST APRIL 9th.
